Terms of Use – www.iowafadresponse.com

Please read these terms and conditions completely before using www.iowafadresponse.com (the “Website”). The Website is composed of various web pages controlled by the College of Veterinary Medicine and Biomedical Sciences (sometime also referred to as “TAMU”).

Acceptance of the Terms of Use

This agreement documents the legally binding terms and conditions (collectively “Terms of Use”) that govern the use of this Website.
